The Merits of Fatima al Zahra

3rd Ramazan was the Demise Date of Sayyidah Fatima al Zahra ~razi Allahu anha~, we have collected her brief biography and her special Merits in the below lines. But, before we proceed further, we shall present a brief list of important books on the topic.

Major Books on the Merits of Ahl al Bayt (the Household of the Prophet)

Some Books on the Merits of Ahl al Bayt

Through out Islamic history Muhaddithin have compiled numerous Hadiths in the Merits of 'Ahl al Bayt' in their Hadith collections under the titles 'Kitab al Fazail' or 'Kitab al Manaqib'. Some Muslim Scholars have also penned books specially dedicated to the merits of the respected Sayyids. These are:

- 1. 'Istijlab Irtiqa al Ghuraf bi Hubb Aqriba al Rasul wa Dhawi al Sharf' by Imam Shamsuddin Sakhawi Shafai' Misri.
- 2. 'Al Zakhair al Uqba fi Manaqib Dhaw al Qurba' by Imam Muhibb al Tibri Shafai'.
- 3. 'Al Ilm al Zahir fi Nafai' Nasab al Tahir' by the great Hanafi Jurist Imam Sayyid Ibn Abidin Shami.
- **4.** 'Ahya al Mayyit fi Fazail al Ahli Bayt' by the giant Hafiz of Hadith Imam Jalaluddin Suyuti Shafai'.
- 5. 'Irath al Adab li Fazil al Nasab' & 'Az Zahr al Basim fi Hurmat iz Zakat ala Bani Hashim' by Imam al Akbar Ahmad Raza Khan Quadri Bareilvi.
- **6.** 'Al Sharf al Mawbad li Aali Muhammad' by Imam Yusuf bin Ismail Nabhani Shafai'.
- 7. 'Al Kalam al Maqbul fi Taharat il Nasab al Rasul' by the giant Indian Mufassir Mufti Ahmad Yaar Khan Ashrafi Nayimi.

In all there are more than 600 Hadiths in the Merits of 'Ahl al Bayt' in different books of Hadiths.

Two Specifc & Major Books on the Merits of Sayyidah Fatima

1. Imam Hakim Nayshapuri (d. 405 A.H) was perhaps the first to compile a separate book on the Merits of Sayyidah Fatima entitled 'Fazail Fatima al Zahra' in which he collected 232 Hadiths. Imam Hakim has narrated many of these

Merits in his other famous Hadith book – 'Mustadrak al Sahihayn' also known as 'Mustadrak al Hakim'. Subsequent Muhaddithin depended and relied upon this book to pen their works.

2. Imam Jalaluddin Suyuti Shafai' (d. 911 A.H) also authored a brief yet beautiful book – 'Al Sughur al Basima fi Manaqib Sayyidatina Fatima bint RasulAllah' on the Merits of Sayyidah Fatima *~razi Allahu anha~*. Infact, this is also a short Biography of Sayyidah Fatima as well.

Apart from these two great Muhaddithin, numerous other scholars have collected the Hadiths on the Merits of Sayyidah Tayyiba Zahida Tahira Fatima ~razi Allahu anha~ in their respective books including the authors of 'Sihah Sittah'. We shall present a brief Biography of Sayyidah Fatima ~razi Allahu anha~ from these books along with her Specific Merits.

The Birth of Sayyidah Fatima

The Historians have differed as regards to the exact date and year of Sayyidah Fatima's ~razi Allahu anha~ Birth. According to the Historian Abu Umar, she was born in the First year after the Declaration of Prophet-hood by RasulAllah~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~. According to others, she was born a year before the Declaration of Prophet-hood, when the Prophet ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ was 39 years of age. While, according to Imam Ibn Jawzi, she was born Five years prior to the Declaration of Prophet-hood.

Why the name 'Fatima'?

Sayyiduna Jabir narrates that the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ said: "My Daughter was named Fatima because Allah has totally separated her and those who Love her from the Fire <of Hell>." {Musnad al Daylami; H #1385 * Kanz al Ummal; H # 34227 * Istijlab Irtiqa al Ghuraf bi Hubb Agriba al Rasul wa Dhawi al Sharf (p.96)}

The Mother of Sayyidah Fatima

The Mother of Sayyidah Fatima ~razi Allahu anha~ was Sayyidah Khadijah al Kubra ~razi Allahu anha~ – the Beloved wife of RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ and First Muslim Woman! There are Hadiths on her Merits also which are as follows:

Sayyiduna Abdullah bin Abbas ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrates that the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ drew four lines in the ground and asked: "Do you know what this is?" The Sahaba (Companions) replied: "Allah and His Rasul know better!" Then the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa

sallam~said: "From the Women of Paradise Four are Superior to others: <Sayyidah> Khadijah bint Khuwaylid, <Sayyidah> Fatima bint Muhammad, <Sayyidah> Asiyah bint Mazahim - the wife of Pharaoh and <Sayyidah> Maryam bint Imran." {Fazail al Sahaba; H # 250 & 259 of Imam Nisai * Sahih Ibn Hibban; H #7010 * Mustadrak al Hakim; H # 3836}

Salih narrates that <Sayyidah> Ayesha ~razi Allahu anha~ said to <Sayyidah> Fatima~razi Allahu anha~: "Shall I not tell you some good news? I have heard the Prophet say that only four women are the Leaders of the Women of Paradise: <Sayyidah> Maryam bint Imran, <Sayyidah> Fatima bint RasulAllah, <Sayyidah> Khadijah bint Khuwaylid and Pharaoh' s wife, <Sayyidah> Asiyah." {Fazail al Sahabah; H # 1336 of Imam Ahmad bin Hanbal}

The Mariage of Sayyidah Fatima

The Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ received many proposals for Sayyidah Fatima ~razi Allahu anha~ from great Sahaba due to her being the daughter of the Prophet ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~, due to her nobility and due to lofty character and merits. The Prophet ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~declined the proposals of numerous Sahaba including the proposals of Sayyiduna Abu Bakr al Siddiq ~razi Allahu anhu~ and Sayyiduna Umar bin Khattab ~razi Allahu anhu~ and said to them: "I await the Command of Allah Almighty as regards to her marriage!" Then came the Order of Allah Almighty as is evident from the Below Hadiths:

Sayyiduna Abdullah bin Masud ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrates that the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ said: "Allah Almighty has ordered me to arrange <Sayyidah> Fatima's marriage with <Sayyiduna> Ali!" {Mu'jam al Kabir; H# 10305 & H# 1020 * Kanz al Ummal; H # 32891 & 32929 & H# 37753}

The Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ said: "O Anas! Do you know what Message <Sayyiduna> Jibrail has brought from the Owner of the Throne <i.e. Allah Almighty>?" Then he said: "Allah Almighty has ordered me to Arrange <Sayyidah> Fatima's marriage with <Sayyiduna> Ali!" {'Zakhair al Uqba fi Manaqib Dhaw al Qurba (p.71)}

The Marriage of Sayyidah was Solemnized with Sayyiduna Ali in the Heavens

Sayyiduna Anas bin Malik *~razi Allahu anhu~* narrates that when the Beloved RasulAllah *~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~* was in the Masjid, he said to *<*Sayyiduna*>* Ali: "This is *<*Sayyiduna*>* Jibrail who is telling me that Allah Almighty has performed your marriage ceremony to *<*Sayyidah*>* Fatima in the presence of **Forty Thousand**

Angels as Witnesses to the marriage ceremony. He <i.e. Allah Almighty> said to the tree of 'Tuba' {Blessings} to rain Pearls and Rubies on them. The tree showered them with pearls and rubies. Then women with beautiful eyes gathered the pearls and rubies in trays which the angels (present in the ceremony) will present to each other as gifts until the Day of Judgement!" {Al Riyad al Nadarah fi Manaqib al Ashrah (3:146) * Zakhair al Uqba fi Manaqib Dhaw al Qurba (p.72)}

Sayyiduna Ali bin Abu Talib ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrates that the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ said: "An angel came to me and said: "O Muhammad! Allah Almighty sends 'Salam' {Peace/ Salutations} upon you and says: 'I had your daughter married to <Sayyiduna> Ali bin Abu Talib in the Upper Heavens and now you also arrange the marriage ceremony of <Sayyidah> Fatima with <Sayyiduna> Ali on Earth!" {Zakhair al Uqba fi Manaqib Dhaw al Qurba (p.72)}

The One Born in the House of RasulAllah was Married off to the One Born inside the House of Allah!

Sayyidah Fatima ~razi Allahu anha~ was married off to Sayyiduna Ali bin Abu Talib ~razi Allahu anhu~ in the 2 Hijri. The 'Khutbah' of 'Nikah' was delivered by the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~. In other words: "The one Born in the House of RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ was married to the one Born inside the House of Allah! <i.e. sayyiduna="" ali="" bin="" abu="" talib="">~razi Allahu anhu~></i.e.>

Among the Specialities {'Khasais'} of Sayyidah Fatima ~razi Allahu anha~ bint RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ was that it was 'Haram' {Prohibited} for Sayyiduna Ali bin Abu Talib to marry another woman as long as she lived!

Sayyiduna Miswar bin Makhramah ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrated that he heard the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ saying from the Pulpit that: "Bani Hisham bin Mughirah has seeked permission from me to marry off her daughter to <Sayyiduna> Ali <bin Abu Talib>. I do not give him permission, I do not give him permission, and I do not give him permission!" Then the Prophet ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ said: "My Daughter – Fatima is a Part of My Body, the thing that disturbs her, disturbs me and the thing that Hurts her, hurts me!" {Sahih al Muslim; H # 2449 * Jami' al Tirmizi; H # 3867 * Sunan Abu Dawud; H # 2071 * Sunan Ibn Majah; H # 1998}

The Children of Sayyidah Fatima Sons:

- i. Imam Sayyid Hasan bin Ali bin Abu Talib al Hashmi. ~razi Allahu anhu~
- ii. Imam Sayyid Husayn bin Ali bin Abu Talin al Hashmi *~razi Allahu* anhu~.
- iii. Imam Sayyid Muhsin bin Ali bin Abu Talib al Hashmi *~razi Allahu anhu~*. (Passed away as a child).

Daughters:

- i. Sayyidah Zaynab bint Ali bin Abu Talib al Hashmiya ~*razi Allahu anha*~. She was married to Sayyiduna Abdullah bin Ja'far bin Abu Talib ~*razi Allahu anhu*~.
- ii. Sayyidah Umm al Kulthum bint Ali bin Abu Talib al Hashmiya ~razi Allahu anha~. She was married to Amir al Mu'minin Sayyiduna Umar bin Khattab ~razi Allahu anhu~. They had a son named Sayyiduna 'Zayd' bin Umar bin Khattab ~razi Allahu anhu~ (also known as Ibn Khalifatayn i.e. the Son of Two Khalifas!), he passed away in his childhood. They also had a daughter Sayyidah Ruqayyah ~razi Allahu anha~ bint Umar bin Khattab~razi Allahu anhu~, she also passed away in childhood.
- iii. Sayyidah Ruqayyah bint Ali bin Abu Talib al Hashmiya ~razi Allahu anha~. (Passed away as a child).

The Beloved RasulAllah Informed Sayyidah of Her Demise!

Sayyidah Ayesha Siddiga ~razi Allahu anha~ narrates: "Fatima came and her way of walking was just like that of RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~. The Prophet welcomed his Beloved Daughter and seated her on his right hand side or on the left hand side (the narrator has doubt on the actual side). Then he whispered something to her which made her cry. So I asked her why she was cried. Then the Prophet whispered something to her and she laughed. So I said: "I have never seen happiness so close to sadness as I have seen today." I asked <Sayyidah> Fatima: "What did the Prophet say?" She replied: "I cannot disclose the secret of the RasulAllah!" When the Prophet passed away I asked her again (about that incident) and she replied: "The Prophet whispered to me: "Every year <Sayyiduna> Jibrail recites the whole of the Quran with me once but this year he has recited it twice. I am sure that the end of my time in this world has neared and indeed you are the first from my family who will come to me!" This made me cry. Then the Prophet whispered: "Are you not happy with the fact that you are the Leader of the Women of Paradise or the Leader of all Muslim Women." Upon this I laughed." {Sahih al Bukhari; H # 1326, 1327, 3426, 3427 & Sahih al Muslim, H # 1904 & 2450}

The Demise of Sayyidah Fatima

Umm al Mu'minin Sayyidah Umm Salma ~razi Allahu anha~ narrates: "When Fatima had the illness which took her life, I used to nurse her. One morning, her condition was slightly better. <Sayyiduna> Ali had gone out for some work.

<Sayyiduna> Fatima ~razi Allahu anha~ said: "O Mother! Bring some water for me to Bathe." I brought some water and as far as I saw she bathed perfectly. Then she said: "O Mother! Bring me new Clothes" so I gave her new clothes and she wore them. Then she said: "O Mother! Make my Bed for me in the Middle of the Room" so I did accordingly. Then she laid down, faced towards the Kabah (Qibla), placed her hand under her cheek and said: "O Mother! It is time for my Death and I have purified myself. Do not let anybody undress (touch) me." Sayyidah Fatima passed away in that very position."

Umm al Mu'minin ~razi Allahu anha~ says: "When <Sayyiduna> Ali came back and I informed him of <Sayyidah> Fatima's death." {Fazail al Sahabah by Imam Ahmad bin Hanbal; H # 1074, 1243 & Zakhair al Uqba fi Manaqib Dhaw al Qurba (p.103)}

Sayyidah Fatima ~razi Allahu anha~ passed away on Tuesday, the 3rd of Ramazan 11 Hijri, Six months after the Demise of RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~! She was the first amongst the Sahaba to join the Prophet! Her Funeral 'Salah' was led by Sayyiduna Abbas bin Abdul Muttalib or Sayyiduna Ali bin Abu Talib, and she was buried in 'Jannat al Baqi' graveyard of Madinah al Munawwarah.

Some Lofty Merits of Fatima

Sayyidah Fatima is the Leader of all Muslim Women!

Sayyidah Ayesha Siddiqa ~razi Allahu anha~ narrates that the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ said during the illness in which he passed away: "O Fatima! Are you not pleased with the fact that you are the Leader of the Women of all the Worlds, the Leader of the Women of this 'Ummah' (Nation) and the Leader of the Women of all the Believers?" {Mustadrak al Hakim; H # 4740}

Masruq narrates from Umm al Mu'minin Sayyida Ayesha ~razi Allahu anha~ that the Beloved Prophet ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ said: "Fatima, are you not happy that you are the Leader of the Women of all the Believers or the Leader of the Women of this 'Ummah'." {Sahih al Bukhari; H # 2317, 5928 & Sahih al Muslim; H # 1905, 2450}

Sayyiduna Abu Hurayrah ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrates that the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ said: "An angel in the skies who had not visited me requested permission from Allah to visit me; he told me the good

news or brought me the news that Fatima is the Leader of all Women in my 'Ummah' (Nation)." {Mujam al Kabir ; H # 1006}

Sayyiduna Huzayfah ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrates that the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ said: "There is an angel who had never come down to earth before this night, he asked permission from his Lord to offer 'Salam' (Salutations) to me and to deliver the good news to me that Fatima is the Leader of all Women of Paradise and Hasan and Husayn are the Leaders of all the Youngsters in Paradise." {Jami al Tirmizi; H # 3781 * Mustadrak al Hakim; H # 4721 & 4722}

Sayyiduna Ali bin Abu Talib ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrates that the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ said to Fatima: "Are you not happy that you are the Leader of all Women in Paradise and both of your sons are Leaders of all Youth in Paradise." {Musnad al Bazzar; H #885}

Whoever Pleases Sayyidah Fatima, Pleases Allah Almighty & Whoever Angers her, Angers Allah!

Sayyiduna Ali bin Abu Talib ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrates that the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ said to Fatima: "Indeed! Allah becomes Angry when you are Angry and He is Pleased when you are Pleased." {Mustadrak al Hakim; H # 4730 * Majma al Zawaid (9:203)}

The Beloved Habib said to Sayyidah: "My Father & Mother be Sacrificied for You!

Sayyiduna Abdullah bin Umar ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrates that whenever the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ went on a journey, the last person he would speak to from his family before setting off would be <Sayyidah> Fatima. When he returned from a journey, the first person the Prophet would come to would be <Sayyidah> Fatima and RasulAllah would say to her: "(O Fatima!) My Mother and Father be sacrificed for you." {Mustadrak al Hakim; H #4740 * Sahih Ibn Hibban; H # 696}

Sayyiduna Umar bin Khattab ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrates that the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ used to say to <Sayyidah> Fatima "(O Fatima!) My Mother and Father be sacrificed for you." {Durr al Sahabah fi Managib al Qarabah wal Sahaba (p. 279)}

Sayyidah is a Part of the Beloved RasulAllah!

Sayyiduna Miswar bin Makhramah ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrates that the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ said: "Fatima is a Part of me. Therefore whosoever Angers her Angers me." {Sahih al Bukhari; H #3510 & 3556 * Sahih al Muslim; H # 2449 * Mustadrak al Hakim; H # 4747}

Sayyiduna Muhammad bin Ali ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrates that the Beloved RasulAllah said: "Indeed Fatima is a part of me. Hence, whosoever Angers her Angers me." {Fazail al Sahabah; H #1326 of Imam Ahmad bin Hanbal * Zakhair al Uqba fi Manaqib Dhaw al Qurba (p.80-81)}

Sayyiduna Ali bin Abu Talib ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrates: "He was present in the company of RasulAllah when the Beloved Prophet asked: 'What is Best for a Woman?' The Sahaba (Companions) remained silent on this. When I returned home I asked Fatima: "Tell me what is best for a woman?" <Sayyidah> Fatima replied: "It is best for a Woman that no Men (i.e. out side of one's immediate family: brothers, father, uncle, husband, sons) see her." I mentioned this to the Prophet and he said: "Indeed Fatima is a Part of me." {Musnad al Bazzar; H #526}

Sayyidah is a Human 'Hur' in this World!

Sayyiduna Anas bin Malik ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrated that the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ said: "Fatima is a Part of My Body, and She is a Human 'Hur'!" {Tarikh al Baghdad; H # 6772 (12: 328)}

The Beloved RasulAllah used to Stand and Kiss Sayyidah Fatima upon her Coming!

Umm al Mu'minin Sayyidah Ayesha Siddiqa ~razi Allahu anha~ narrates that when the Beloved RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ used to see <Sayyidah> Fatima coming, he would welcome her, then he would stand up for her, kiss her, bring her inside by holding her hand and seat her in his own place! Whenever <Sayyidah> Fatima saw the Prophet arrive, she used to welcome him, stand up for him and kiss the Prophet." {Sahih Ibn Hibban; H # 6953 * Mu'jam al Awsat; H # 4089 * Mustadrak al Hakim; H # 7715 * Al Adab al Mufrad; H #947}

Umm al Mu'minin Sayyidah Ayesha Siddiqa ~razi Allahu anha~ narrates that when Sayyidah Fatima used to arrive in the presence of the Prophet, he used to welcome her by standing up and used to hold her hand and kiss it then seat her where he was sitting." {Mustadrak al Hakim; H # 4732 * Fazail al Sahabah; H # 264 of Imam Nisai}

Umm al Mu'minin Sayyidah Ayesha Siddiqa ~razi Allahu anha~ narrates that when Sayyidah Fatima used to visit the Prophet, he used to stand up to welcome her, kiss her and by holding her hand used to seat her where he was sitting. When the Prophet visited Fatima's house, she in welcoming the Prophet, used to stand up and kiss the blessed hand of the Prophet." {Mustadrak al Hakim; H # 4753 * Zakhair al Uqba fi Manaqib Dhaw al Qurba (p.85)}

The Beloved RasulAllah Laid out his Cloak for Sayyidah and her family to Sit!

Sayyiduna Ali bin Abu Talib ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrates that he arrived in the company of the Belovd RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ and the Prophet had already laid out a cloak. The Prophet, Ali, Fatima, Hasan and Husayn sat on it. Then the Prophet got hold of the corners of the cloak, placed the corners over them and tied a knot. Then he said: "O Allah! Be Pleased with them in the same manner as I am Pleased with them!" {Mu'jam al Awsat; H #5514}

The Beloved RasulAllah used to Start all Journeys After Meeting Sayyidah Fatima!

Sayyiduna Sawban~razi Allahu anhu~, the (freed) Slave of RasulAllah ~sal Allahu alayhi wa sallam~ narrates that whenever the Prophet intended to go on a journey, the last person he would speak to from his family before setting off would be <Sayyidah> Fatima. Once he returned from a journey, the first person the Prophet would come to would be <Sayyidah> Fatima." {Sunan Abu Dawud; H # 4213}

Sayyidah was the Most Beloved to RasulAllah & Sayyiduna Ali was the Most Dearer!

Jumai bin Umayr Taymi narrates that he visited <Sayyidah> Ayesha in the company of his paternal aunt and asked her: "Who was the most Beloved to the Prophet?" Umm al Mu'minin replied: "Fatima!" She was then asked: "And who from among the men?" She replied: "Her husband <Sayyiduna Ali>. As far as I know he fasts a great deal and he often stays awake at length during nights in order to worship Allah!" {Jami' al Tirmizi; H #3874 * Mustadrak al Hakim; H #4744 * Zakhair al Uqba fi Manaqib Dhaw al Qurba (p.77)}

Sayyiduna Buraydah ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrates that: "From the women <Sayyidah> Fatima was the most Beloved to the Prophet and from the men <Sayyiduna> Ali was most Dear to him!" {Jami' al Tirmizi; H # 3868 * Mustadrak al Hakim; H # 4735}

Sayyiduna Abu Salamah bin Abdul Rahman ~razi Allahu anhu~ narrates that Sayyiduna Usamah bin Zayd ~razi Allahu anhu~ told him: "I was sitting when <Sayyiduna> Ali and <Sayyiduna> Abbas came to seek permission and said: "Usama, take permission from the Prophet for us to enter." I said: "Ya RasulAllah! Ali and Abbas seek permission to enter." The Prophet said: "Do you know why they have come?" I replied: "No" He said: "But I know. Let them come in." Both of them entered and they said: "Ya RasulAllah! We have come to ask you that who from "the Ahl al Bayt" (People of your house) is most Beloved to you." The Prophet replied: "Fatima – Bint Muhammad!" {Jami' al Tirmizi; H # 3819 * Mustadrak al Hakim; H # 3526}
